Daily high and low temperature

Over the course of the year, temperature typically varies from -3°C to 14°C and is rarely below -9°C or above 17°C

The "warm season" lasts from June 10 to September 6 with an average daily high temperature above 12°C. The "cold season" lasts from November 10 to April 3 with an average daily high temperature below 4°C.





Daily hours of daylight and twilight

The length of the day varies significantly over the course of the year. The shortest day is December 21 with 4:08 hours of daylight and the longest day is June 20 with 21:11 hours of daylight.

Thingvellir national park. Home of Iceland's parliament from 930-1798 Thingvellir is also the point on Earth's surface where the North Atlantic ridge splits the two geological continents of North America and Eurasia.

Geysir, the original geyser, geothermal hot spring area is our next stop, One of the most popular tourist attractions in Iceland due to the frequency of the geysers spouting 100 feet in the air.

Gullfoss waterfall, known for it scenic beauty, set on three plateaus, falls 32 meters from the glacial river Hvítá originating in Langjökull glacier.

Northern lights

Iceland is one of the world's most accessible spots for viewing the northern lights, The best season to see the northern lights in Iceland is from September to mid-April.

The northern lights are the result of electrically charged particles from the sun colliding with gaseous particles in the Earth's atmosphere, causing displays of bright, colourful dancing lights. They are visible in the magnetic polar regions of the northern and southern hemispheres they can range in colour from white, green, pink and purple.
