


Austria is a nation reimagining ideas. This is reflected in its decision to use 9,000-year-old soil to build its pavilion, which comprises 47 truncated cones.



Native to Turkmenistan and symbolising national pride, horses will play a prominent role in this pavilion experience that promises to immerse the senses.









Day 3: Heritage Safari – Sustainable Desert Safaris In Dubai

History comes to life with our private collection of museum quality Land Rover vehicles, our Bedouin camp using natural wood and stone, nestled inside the privacy of a royal desert retreat, Emirati recipes prepared using traditional methods, demonstrations of heritage entertainment and the exploration and conservation of the natural habitat.

Guests will be guided by an expert tour guide to discover some of the rare animals that the barren landscape has to offer including the stunning desert monitors, gazelle, Arabian Oryx or the Arabian Wildcat, among other wildlife. The Dubai Desert Conservation Reserve is the largest conservation project in the UAE. In order to assist the conservationists with their important work, we donate proceeds from each guest.

INTERACTIVE FALCONRY EXPERIENCE

Falconry is an integral part of desert life which has been practiced in the UAE for centuries, originally used for hunting to supplement the Bedouin diet with meat, such as hare or houbara. Set inside the private retreat of a member of the Royal family, on a simple set-up of comfortable cushions on Arabian silk carpets, you will experience falcon training techniques.

AUTHENTIC BEDOUIN CAMP

PLATINUM HERITAGE is the only company in the UAE operating inside the grounds of a Royal family member's private desert retreat.

Discover our fine-dining experience nestled inside the exclusive grounds, constructed using natural materials like stone, wood and goat hair for an authentic heritage styled camp. We will demonstrate authentic cultural activities such as camel rides, henna tattoos, Khaleeji and Yola dance, Arabic bread and coffee making before enjoying a scrumptious dinner under the stars accompanied by Emirati music. SOUP

SHORBAT ADAS - Lentil soup, a regional favourite, especially during the winter months (lentils, onion, black pepper, cumin, lime, coriander, potato, carrots, garlic, celery)

STARTERS

KIBBEH - With variations from around the Arabian world, kibbeh has been a popular choice for generations (wheat grains, minced beef, onion, spices, pine seeds)

SAMBOUSEK - Discovered during the Crusades, this ancient dish is crispy and flavourful (flour, egg, cheese)

HOUMOUS - A Middle Eastern favourite popular around the world (Chickpeas, tahini, olive oil, lemon juice, salt)

JARJEER - A traditional spring salad from the oasis of UAE, Jarjeer is a fresh addition to any palette (Rocca leaves, tomato, onion, olive oil, lemon juice, salt, sumac)

FATOUSH - Salads were rare in the region, however Fatoush from the Levant has become a regional favourite (Mixed with lettuce, tomato, cucumber, radish, onion, capsicum, green thyme, mint, sumac, olive oil and lemon juice, topped with home baked crispy)

MAIN COURSES

RICE - Vegetable rice and lamb rice

HAREES - A popular dish served on all occasions and at large gatherings (beef, wheat grains, salt, ghee, spices)

TRADITIONAL OUZI - A dish that symbolizes hospitality in the region. Our Arabic spiced Lamb is simmered for 6 hours in an underground pit to ensure tenderness, falling off the bone

CAMEL MEAT - A traditional dish for all special occasions (Spiced with mixed vegetables)

SHEESH TAWOUK - Grilled cubes of marinated chicken breast (garlic, lemon, yoghurt, salt and Arabic spices)

GRILLED VEGETABLE KEBAB

Served with mushroom, potato, red and green pepper, aubergine and cherry tomatoes accompanied with a freshly sliced avocado (to be ordered in advance)

DESSERTS

LGEIMAT - Originating from the Arabic word meaning "a small bite that can be eaten in a single mouthful", these small delectable Arabic style donuts are served drizzled with date syrup

ASSORTED FRESH FRUIT

Mixed seasonal fresh fruit platters

BEVERAGES

Sparkling date juice, Arabic coffee, mineral water, a selection of two fresh juices, vimto, camel milk, karak chai and a selection of tea and coffee











Day 4: Masdar City visit + Sheikh Zayed Mosque

MASDAR CITY

Masdar City is an ecosystem integrating urban planning, knowledge, research and development. Our focus during the tour is livelihood, innovation and sustainability of Masdar City. By pushing the boundaries of design and innovative technology, it offers a innovative ecosystem housing pioneering R&D and pilot facilities that nurture and implement ground-breaking solar energy, energy storage, green building and urban sustainability projects. Masdar City's template for a sustainable city also showcases the effective deployment of passive design that is tailored for arid, desert regions.

During this tour, we emphasize the design of the buildings and the planning of the city: Some time is taken to specifically discuss the absence of cars and how life is organised (neighborhood shops, accessibility of administrations...) as well as the general design of streets, the urban natural cooling, and the buildings architecture.

Understanding how Ancient Arab architecture was used in Masdar Cityis vital in order to understand the importance and richness of UAE culture and history. The Burjeel, the Msharrabiyye, the narrow streets... All these are elements from Arab architecture that were modernised using present technologies and are used in Masdar.

ABU DHABI CITY TOUR

Abu Dhabi is the capital of the United Arab Emirates and the residence of the Federal National Council. Recognized as one of the world's largest producers of oil, Abu Dhabi is undergoing a massive diversification of its economy and is investing in many different areas such as commerce, tourism and culture.
