



# LOVCEN NATIONAL PARK Adrenaline rush



Lovcen national park occupies a special place in the hearts of all Montenegrins. For most of its history it represented the entire nation – a rocky island of Slavic resistance in an Ottoman sea. Two-thirds of the national park's 6220 hectares are covered in woods, particularly the black beech that gives it its moody complexion. The park is home to various types of reptile, 85 species of butterfly and large mammals such as brown bears and wolves. The 200 avian species found here include regal birds of prey such as the peregrine falcon, golden eagle and imperial eagle.

The mountains are criss-crossed with hiking paths and mountain-biking trails.

Good to know to come prepared as the temperature is on average 10°C cooler than on the coast.

































### NJEGOSH MAUSOLEUM

Njegosh mausoleum, situated at 1657 m above the sea, on the second highest peak of Lovcen mountain, represents one of the MUST VISIT places and attractions.

461 steps lead to this magnificent mausoleum, tomb of Montenegrin prince-bishop, poet and philosopher Petar Petrovic II Njegos. Inside the mausoleum, under a golden mosaic, you will find grandiose sculpture of Njegos, created by famous sculptor Ivan Mestrovic. Dramatic circular viewpoint, provide spectacular experience, and maybe you will be lucky enough to see Italian coast.








## RESTAURANT IVANOV KONAK

# CETINJE – THE FIRST CAPITAL OF MONTENEGRO

It may seem to you that Cetinje fell into the deep sleep, but it just rests after its long turbulent past, which began in the 15th century. In order to protect its folk of the Otoman invasion and preserve the orthodox religion and culture, the great emperor Ivan Crnojevic left the fertile area of Skadar lake and found the shelter in the raw area of Lovcen Mount. Having built his palace, he founded the new seat of the old Montenegro, the town of Cetinje.

In the center of the town, you will see the bequest of the most important Montenegrins, Petrovic Dynasty, which ruled the country over 200 years: Biljarda - residence of the bishop, writer and philosopher Petar II Petrovic Njegos, King Nikola's Palace, Monastery of Cetinje... Montenegro was in that time constantly struggling against Turks for the independence of their homeland and finally gained it at the end of the 19th century and attracted various European countries to open their embassies in this small town.



## **BOKA BAY**

Often referred to as the southernmost fjord in Europe, the Boka Bay is in fact a drowned river canyon. The high mountains that bend around the coastline protect the bay from the open sea and from the cold climate of the north in winter. This allows an abundance of Mediterranean vegetation to grow: agave, palm, mimosa, oleander, kiwi, pomegranate and medicinal herbs can all flourish in these temperatures. Combination of calm sea and beautiful mountains will take your breath away.

#### EXPLORING THE OLD TOWN OF KOTOR



Walking city tour of the Old Town of Kotor will give you a great introduction to this UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Kotor is situated in the most secluded part of the Bay of Kotor. While it dates from the Illyrian period, Kotor developed into an important commercial and artistic center in the Middle Ages. Many empires battled for control over the city throughout the centuries: from being an autonomous city of the Byzantine Empire, free city of medieval Serbia, then under Venetian or Hungarian states, gaining independence and then returned to Venetian control once again, just to be occupied by France and then Austria, until Kotor finally became part of Yugoslavia. The tour will take you inside the city gates, and you will visit: the Square of Arms, Clock Tower, St Tryphon Cathedral, ....


















#### WE RUN DMC

#### **OUR LADY OF THE ROCKS**



Our Lady of the Rock lies about 115 m (377 feet) northeast of the island of St. George. The stone plateau in the middle of the sea with a church on it is the result of the enduring efforts of generations of mariners "... to leave there, in the very heart of the Bay of Boka Kotorska, a testimony of their Christian faith and culture..."

The island was built artificially by scuttling old ships and depositing stones around a small crag. The name of the island derived from the word "skrpjel" – an old word for a crag. The construction of a sanctuary began in the first century of the Venetian rule. The sanctuary was dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin because this cult (Assunzione della Vergine) was greatly venerated by the Venetians.

This restaurant by the beach is unique in its own right and will offer its guests a cozy setting with a relaxed vibe, right after the ferry in Kamenari.



## DAY 4. WINERY SAVINA, VISIT & WINE TASTING



The story of Savina winery is really a story of an estate, of a monastery and of the owners family.

At the entrance to the Bay of Kotor, by Savina Monastery, sun-soaked vineyards are today bearing fruit much like they did back in the 18th century. The wines are characterized by a light and breezy, summer style. This is true for the Chardonnay and Rose, but even for red wines which are nurtured by the family Obradovic, owners of the winery. The legacy of the monastery is more 350 years old, and the land has been always suitable for grapes that grew on it.

The vineyard spreads it self into two hectares and has international grape varietals (Shiraz, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Grenache, Chardonnay) and one indigenous white varietal, Žižak (*zhizhak*), similar to Dubrovnik's Malvasia (as opposed to the Istrian one). The vineyards are located in the best part of the estate, with southern exposition, with a spectacular view over the sea.



Sinjajevina range. Absolutely unique place, with countless cliffside bends and tunnels.



Kolašin is only 70 kilometres away from the capital city of Podgorica and its international airport. The hotel is located right in the centre of Kolasin, with its small bars and cafes, and connected with the The Ski Resort Kolasin which is only 9km away. 


## RAFTING -SPLAVISTE -ZUGIC LUKA

Our rafting starting point is Splaviste, where traditional Montenegrin snack will be served.

During the rafting you will have opportunity to see the shortest and (depending on the season) most powerful river in Europe -Ljutica, as well as the famous Djurdjevica Bridge – the architectural marvel of its time.

While leisurely sailing down the crystal clean waters of the cleanest river in Europe you will be enjoying the spectacular natural surroundings: stone and gravel terraces, wild beaches, mysterious cliffs, icy waterfalls, high cliffs on which pine trees over hundred years old and 50 meters high grow..

Passing through the National Park Durmitor, after 14 kilometers long rafting tour you will arrive at the place Zugic Luka, which is the first raft camp on the Tara River, where our rafting ends.



Lunch is organized at the restaurant overlooking the Tara Canyon and the Djurdjevica bridge.



## ZIP LINE -DJURDJEVICA TARA

#### ZIP LINE OVER THE BIGGEST CANYON IN EUROPE

Tara river Canyon is 1333 m deep, which makes it the deepest in Europe, and after Colorado Canyon, second in the world. It's fascinating just by itself, isn't it? And now imagine that you fly over that natural phenomenon only hanging from a cable. Real treat even for the greatest lovers of extreme adventures and wilderness.

How does it look to fly 170 m above forested cliffs that surround fast mountain river? Unforgettable.

At the thought, adrenaline starts to rush through your veins, and then, the heart starts to beat fast and just when reasons to give up start to come up in your head, in front of you emerges endless greenery and blue Tara river. The trill is growing at light speed, feeling of freedom and power overwhelms you, and maybe you would want to shout the louder...

## JEEP SAFARI –BJELASICA



Our 4x4 adventure begins in Kolasin and continues across one of the most beautiful mountains in Montenegro-Bjelasica. From the ski resort we take an off road and drive up to the mountain passing by traditional villages-"katuns". Upon arrival to the mountain hut Vranjak, 1740 m above sea level we will make a short photo stop and proceed to the viewpoint situated at the foothills of highest peaks of Bjelasica, from where you will enjoy the magnificent view of the pešića lake.

During the trip the road takes us over the "roof" of the Bjelasica mountain along the foothills of the three highest peaks Crna glava 2139m, Zekova glava 2117m and Troglava 2072m. Further on , we enter the national park Biogradska gora and drive to the most attractive viewpoint Bendovac at 1800m of altitude. From this place stunning view is spreading on the whole virgin forest of the Biogradska gora with the Biogradsko lake in the middle of it . We will make another photo stop after which we will proceed through the scenic area of the Bjelasica mountain to the Katun Dolovi (1724m), where the refreshment & lunch will be organized.

From Dolovi we will continue along the serpentine road through the Biogradska virgin forest all the way to the Biogradsko lake which is situated at the heart of the national park and is surrounded by thick forest, which makes it unique and leaves a lifetime impression on all those who had a chance to visit it.

## KATUN GOLES


Shepherd katun (katun is a small mountain village made of huts inhabited by shepherds in the summer) Goleš is located and 1600 m a.s.l.

Besides growing vegetables, the Bulatovic family raises livestock.

Fresh milk is made daily into fresh cheese. This approach means daily freshness whether it is cheese, homemade bread, home made local specialties.

## **ADDITIONAL ACTIVITY OPTIONS**

## **DURMITOR RING**



Pick up by jeeps from Kolasin and drive to Zabljak. From Zabljak we take a road over the mountain and starting by the old ski center Stuoc. We drive further towards the viewpoint where another short break is organized to enjoy a view of the impressive landscape that surrounds you. The drive proceeds through the highest villages, that are populated all year around, in the Balkans (Mala Crna Gora and Nedajno) located at above 2000 m above sea level. These villages strictly regulate rules for living and they are very simple to follow: live in harmony with the nature, you do not have any other choice, since most of the year they are isolated completely from the rest of the world by heavy snowfalls. Leaving the villages behind us we meet Susica Canyon, which represents a natural border between Durmitor and Piva Mountain. After descending to the very bottom of the canyon to see the Susicko Lake if it is not dried up due to prolonged drought periods.
